Curriculum Honours

School Honours are the highest accolade awarded to a student in the Colours/Honours system. Awarding of Honours rewards outstanding significant achievement in the fields of Academic, Cultural, Service and Sport.

Criteria

Achieve ONE of the following criteria:

FULL COLOURS and:

Dux in Year 11 or Top student in 2+ subjects in Year 11.

Year 12 VET Student who has all A grades and has received a Cert III and/or on track to complete a Cert IV end of Semester 1.

Years 10-12 students who placed first, second or third in a National academic competition.

Years 10-12 students who participated internationally in a recognised academic competition.

Criteria

- 1. Students must achieve 11+ points.
- 2. 5 points must be achieved for achievement and performance in curriculum.
- 3. 6 points must be achieved for service and leadership in curriculum.
