



## Sport Honours and Colours

### Sport Honours

School Honours are the highest accolade awarded to a student in the Colours/Honours system. Awarding of Honours rewards outstanding significant achievement in the fields of Academic, Cultural, Service and Sport.

### Criteria

Achieve ONE of the following criteria:

**FULL COLOURS** and:

Years 11-12 students who placed first to third in a sport at national level or has qualified to represent Australia at international level.
---

Years 11-12 students who qualified for national selection in a sport at LJBC.
---

Years 11-12 students partaking in service to LJBC in the sports field over an extended period of time can become eligible for Honours. Students are required to accumulate 24 points over Years 7-12.

Years 11-12 Students who received ACC Letters i.e. ACC All Stars selection over 4 years.

## Sport Full Colours

### Criteria

1. Students must achieve 11+ points recognising contribution to sport at the College over two semesters some of which should be completed either in Years 11 or 12.
2. Special Concessions may be made for a student from another school if she or he was actively involved in community service prior to attending the College.
3. Use the points system below:

Category	Points	Activity/Performance
<b>Achievement, Service and Leadership in Sport</b>	<b>8</b>	State selection <b>AND</b> Demonstrate commendable leadership and portrayed as a positive role model by providing assistance and guidance to others and where possible aiding staff at Carnivals.
	<b>5</b>	ACC All Stars <b>AND/OR</b> 1-3 <sup>rd</sup> place at an ACC Carnival per year <b>AND/OR</b> Holds a record at an ACC Carnival per year  And for all of the above: Demonstrate commendable leadership and portrayed as a positive role model by aiding and guidance to others. Assisting where possible with set up or pack up at Carnivals.
	<b>3</b>	ACC Inter School team selection for 2 years <b>AND/OR</b> 1-3 <sup>rd</sup> Medal at House Carnival <b>AND/OR</b> Sport Delegate – manage a team at an ACC event <b>AND/OR</b> Manage/Coach CAS Team – all rounds of competition and trials/training sessions (if applicable) <b>AND/OR</b> CAS participation for a minimum of 50% of games, unless injured. One team over 2 years.
	<b>1-2</b>	Volunteer Official for CAS or Football Academy per year <b>AND/OR</b> Official at ACC Carnival per year



## Sport Half Colours

### Criteria

1. Students must achieve 10+ points recognising contribution to sport at the College over two semesters some of which should be completed either in Years 11 or 12.
2. Special Concessions may be made for a student from another school if she or he was actively involved in community service prior to attending the College.
3. Use the points system below:

Category	Points	Activity/Performance
<b>Achievement, Service and Leadership in Sport</b>	<b>8</b>	State selection <b>AND</b> Demonstrate commendable leadership and portrayed as a positive role model by providing assistance and guidance to others. Assisting where possible with set up or pack up at Carnivals.
	<b>5</b>	ACC All Stars <b>AND/OR</b> 1-3 <sup>rd</sup> place at an ACC Carnival <b>AND/OR</b> Holds a record at an ACC Carnival  And for all of the above: Demonstrate commendable leadership and portrayed as a positive role model by aiding and guidance to others. Assisting where possible with set up or pack up at Carnivals.
	<b>3</b>	ACC Inter School team selection for 2 years <b>AND/OR</b> 1-3 <sup>rd</sup> Medal at House Carnival <b>AND/OR</b> Sport Delegate – manage a team at an ACC event <b>AND/OR</b> Manager/Coach CAS Team – all rounds of competition and trials/training sessions (if applicable) <b>AND/OR</b> CAS participation for a minimum of 50% of games, unless injured. One team over 2 years.
	<b>1-2</b>	Volunteer Official for CAS or Football Academy <b>AND/OR</b> Official at ACC Carnival
