What happens next

1. All shortlisted applicants will be required to attend an interview.
2. Students applying for music Scholarship will be required to attend an audition.
3. Students applying for an Academic scholarship will be required to sit an assessment.

General Terms and Conditions

Applications are assessed by a Scholarship Committee, whose decision is final.

Students who are awarded a scholarship will be subject to the following rules and conditions:

1. The Scholarship is awarded based on academic merit, the student's application and the interview or audition.
2. The level of assistance granted, is at the discretion of the College Principal.
3. The Scholarship will cover 25% to 50% of tuition fees and does not include sundries, music tuition, the Parent Participation Program (PPP) contribution, subject or course levies, or textbooks.
4. Scholarships are available for students in years 7 to 11.
5. Uniform costs are excluded from the Scholarship.
6. Selection will take place in July/August and the final decision will be taken by the College Scholarship Committee and ratified by the College Principal.
7. A Scholarship will be awarded based on a combination of the following criteria:
 - i. External testing results eg NAPLAN or other.
 - ii. School reports.
 - iii. The student submission and letter of recommendation.
 - iv. Exemplary conduct record.
 - v. Outstanding performance in music or academics
8. The Scholarship may be withdrawn at any time in the event of poor conduct and performance in terms of academic results, following which the parent(s)/legal guardian(s) where scholarship is withdrawn will be responsible for the full payment of ongoing fees.
9. The Scholarship will be reviewed annually by the Scholarship Committee at the end of each year. The review will be conducted on the basis of the student's performance across all areas of school life over the year.
10. The decision of the Scholarship Committee, in association with the College Principal regarding the awarding of a scholarship, is final.
