Instructions for award winners - Please read carefully

Congratulations on receiving an invitation to attend our Year 7 - 11 Awards Evening.

Time

- 1. **6pm** All award winners are required to meet Mrs Yeomans in Founders Hall for an important briefing:
 - Founders Hall is located next to the Canteen
 - Have your name checked off and receive your allocated seat number
 - Please note: If your name is not checked off, you will not receive your award during the evening.
- 2. Students who arrive late, or after the evening has officially commenced will not be able to receive their award during the evening.

Attendance

- 3. Families are required to book up to four (4) free tickets to attend the evening and confirm your child/ren's attendance by **Friday 28 November 2025**.

- 4. If we do **not** receive confirmation (through Humanitix) that you will be present at the night, we will assume you are **not** attending. If you then turn up on the night without having notified us, award(s) will not be presented.
- 5. The Auditorium will be open for families to be seated from 6pm. We look forward to seeing you at the Awards Evening.
- 6. The evening will commence at 6.30pm and should conclude at approximately 8.30pm.
- 7. The College expectation for families who attend the Awards Evening is that they will stay for the whole Year 7-11 ceremony, and not leave part way through. We encourage all families who attend to celebrate the successes of all the students receiving awards.

Uniform requirements for all award recipients

- 8. **Girls**: winter uniform blazer, winter skirt or long grey school trousers, yellow/blue shirt, stockings (preferred)/school socks, tie and black shoes (no jumper) **Boys**: winter uniform blazer, long grey school trousers, yellow/blue shirt, tie, school socks and black shoes (no jumper)
- 9. Please note that all students receiving an award at the Year 7 11 Awards Evening should meet all College uniform and appearance standards as outlined in the Student Planner, otherwise they will not be able to participate.

This includes:

- boys are expected to be clean-shaven
- hair pinned back and off the face, no unnatural colours
- light/natural make up
- correct earrings in the lower lobe of the ear (one earring in each ear only); no facial piercings or plugs
- skirt hem should not be higher than 4cm above the kneecap while standing
- shoes are to be secure and polished

All award winners will sit in the area allocated for award winners. There is no other allocated or reserved seating on the night.
