What happens next?

- 1. All shortlisted applicants will be required to attend an interview with the President of the PCA, College Principal and a member of the PCA Outstanding Collegian Award Committee. Arrangements may be made for a virtual interview under special circumstances.
- 2. Shortlisted applicants will be notified by letter or email by 27 November 2020 regarding the outcome of the interview.
- 3. The winner of the Award will be announced at the annual LJBC Awards Evening.

The process will be conducted in accordance with the LJBC Privacy Policy, posted on the LJBC website: www.ljbc.wa.edu.au.

General terms and conditions

- 1. The Award will be a monetary award of \$ 2 500.
- 2. Selection will take place by 27 November 2020 and the final decision will be taken by the PCA Outstanding Collegian Award Committee (**Committee**).
- 3. The decision of the Committee is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 4. As a condition of the acceptance of the Award, the Award recipient agrees to:
 - i. the publication of photographs of the Award recipient taken by LJBC and/or a PCA volunteer to be published on the LJBC website, PCA Facebook page and any other print or electronic publication that the PCA deems appropriate; and
 - ii. make themselves reasonably available to attend a post-Award interview with the PCA to provide the PCA with information regarding how the Award has been applied by the Award recipient and consents to the publication of the details of the interview including any photographs, video recordings and/or sound recordings of that interview on the LJBC website, PCA Facebook page and any other publication that the PCA deems appropriate.
